



Three years

It looks as if the world is going to rack and ruin. For once, United Nations analysts and all the scientists and independent observers find themselves agreed in forecasting humanity's crisis becoming irreversible by 2010, in three years time.

We have and will keep having always less energy and drinkable water. Always more people, above all children, die and will die of hunger. Always more sick people suffer and will suffer for the lack of cures. The world's wealth is and will always be more concentrated in a few hands. There'll be always less freedom and always more inequality.

The rush to armament continues and armed conflicts are increasing. There are more resources involved in weaponry than in the use of energy for production. War, terrorism and violence risk the security and the existence of human species.

Meanwhile, we have and will always have more air, water and soil pollution. Planet warming is causing and will cause always more unimaginable disasters.

We're in an emergency situation, from nuclear weapons risk to environment destruction, from energy and water scarcity to the poverty of three quarters of humanity, from the progressive loss of peoples' freedom to the deep inequalities, from an always less true information more and more subjected to power to an always more apparent justice.

National states and their international organizations haven't been able and will never carry out their functions for general interest. The same democracies will become always less real, limited by the economic and financial hegemonies and by the superpowers.

Legal tender currencies have reached a total mass higher than forty times the world's yearly produced wealth.

It's a crucial moment in humanity's history. Each human being must undertake his's own responsibility and ask himself what can he do. Each human being must choose between remaining impotent and wait for the events or rebel to forecasts and act to avoid them.

What's needed? First of all peace and equal redistribution of wealth. You have to consider peace not just as result of the solution of conflicts but as requirement to solve them. At the same time, a starting economic equilibrium shall be established, so that everyone will have enough resources to work and produce according to one's own possibilities and requirements.

How? First, taking part to a worldwide body with the authoritativeness of establishing peace on the entire planet without the use of force. Not a super-state but a self-government entity. Second, adopting a real value currency to be assigned in equal parts to all the inhabitants of the planet with over sixteen years of age. Not a new legal tender currency but a free currency, based on work.

Only a world government elected directly by the inhabitants of the Earth can have the authoritativeness to establish peace. Only through a currency entirely guaranteed since it's first issue and representing work it's possible to redistribute wealth.



This is what the Republic of the Earth and Dhana are for.

The Republic of the Earth (www.asmad.org) as maximum expression of the peoples' will. No national government and no international organization can have as much authoritativeness as a world government (the so called universal republic suggested by Kant) directly elected by the people.

Dhana (www.dhana.org) as unique instrument able to cause the re-equilibrium of economic relations. No means can be more effective for this purpose than a world currency adopted by the workers and consumers and, therefore, necessarily by enterprises.

We have only three years time. They are few but we know that historically fundamental choices were taken in short times, this time we have a few days. One just has to realize that to wait without acting and living just for the day trying to save just us is the worst evil. Because each one of us is part of the same system and is tied to all the others. The life of each one of us also depends upon the whole's destiny.

So no more egoism and indifference. Let's gain conscience of reality, lets do it rapidly and we will still be in time to avoid the worst.
